Membership to the choir is regardless of gender, sexual orientation, ability, ethnicity and religion.

Membership of the choir is open to adults and young people living in the local area

Membership fees will be determined annually by the committee

There is no audition.

All applicants who wish to join the choir will be added to the waiting list

All our members will respect and adhere to the Code of Conduct and will be:

- Positive
- Treated fairly

Members should respect the decisions made by the Musical Directors regarding all matters concerning music selection and conduct of the choir at rehearsals and concerts.

Members should dress appropriately for concerts as specified by the Musical Directors.

Members should maintain their music in good condition and return it promptly after each concert or before the concert date if not performing at the concert.

For the safety and comfort of all, we don't expect our members to:

- Make discriminatory jokes or use discriminatory language
- Post negative comments on social media or verbally
- Post photos or videos of the choir on personal social media
